## Management Teams

*Gain 21st century career experience at a high school level!*

The **Film Team** will be called upon to film events and will be run by our Crew Manager. Events can consist of anything from sports games to school concerts to graduation. All filmers will learn the art of camera and audio operation.

The **Edit Team** will edit all of our footage that is filmed by the film team and will be run by the Editing Director. All editors will learn the ins and outs of editing with Adobe Premiere Pro.

The **Church Service Team** will broadcast select church services over our radio station for those who cannot attend church. St. John's and St. Bridget's churches are the churches we broadcast from but you do not need to regularly attend either of these churches to join the team. All members of this team will learn the basics of remote broadcasting and audio production.

**Church services take place on Sunday mornings.** This team is lead by the Church Service Directors. By volunteering a couple of hours a year, joining the Church Service Team is a great way to demonstrate community service while in high school for your college applications and other post-high school plans!

The **Radio Supervising Team** members will each supervise one 2-3 hour block of radio shows every other week. Every radio show must meet the FCC guidelines and it is the radio supervisors job to ensure that each show is doing so by: filling out a sheet of "questions" about each show and accurately taking meter readings from the control room. Radio Supervisors will also answer the phone and relay any requests to the correct radio booth. This team is lead by the Head Supervisor/Programmer.

The **Marketing Team** will work alongside the Marketing Director to produce marketing materials that better/beautify WAVM or inform the public about WAVM's many community service projects. Whether you're a great writer, artist, or anything in between, the marketing is a great fit for anyone.

## Other Interests

**Radio Shows** are 1 hour shows that broadcast live on our radio station 91.7 FM. Shows begin at 2:05 pm and end at 9 pm Monday through Friday.

**Streaming Shows** are 1 hour shows that broadcast live on our website wavm.org. This allows shows to reach a broader audience as those who live out of range of our radio station can listen to the show online. Shows begin at 2:05 pm and end at 9 pm Monday through Friday.

WAVM also has a **TV Station** in which we broadcast pre recorded television shows created by students. Students can create their own idea for a show and we will provide the cameras, audio equipment, and studio. Dining Divas/Manly Cooking are two cooking shows that normally

broadcast on our station and we are looking for students who would like to take part in those as well as students who have their own shows in mind. You can get your own group of tech/talent for shows or you can let us know if you want us to add you into another group.
